5. Upon completion of the survey, relevant results have to be reported by use of appropriate HRS standard forms duly signed by the firm's surveyors and to be handed to H.R.S. attending surveyor.
6. Any changes in facilities, equipment, personnel or operating procedures must be immediately notified to the Society.

This certificate is valid until **20<sup>th</sup> May 2010**, provided that any relevant requirements that may be imposed at the meantime by any additional National legislation of Flag Administration or HRS Rules will be satisfied with.
